1002 Public Participation in the School District

1002.5 Citizens' Concerns about School Personnel

Whenever a citizen has a concern about the action of any employee, the citizen should first be directed to consult with the individual employee about the concern. Next the citizen may give information to the employee's immediate supervisor. If the matter is not resolved, the appeal process will follow this order:

- (1) other supervisory or administrators in the line of responsibility;
- (2) the superintendent of schools;
- (3) the Board of Education,

The Board of Education shall strongly encourage citizens to follow this procedure.

No appeals will be heard by the Board of Education, and no charges against the employees will be investigated or acted upon by the Board, unless they are reduced in writing, signed by the party bringing them, and presented to the Board through the superintendent of schools.
