205 Committees

205.1 Standing Committees

Standing committees may be appointed by the president of the board. The superintendent may be an ex-officio member of each committee. The president may serve as an alternate committee member in the event a regular committee board member is unable to attend.

Committees may submit recommendations to the board or be delegated to act on behalf of the board through majority vote of the members in regard to details within the scope of their respective committees. Other than through these committees, no commitments or decisions on school business can be made by board members except during official board meetings.

Committees will be subject to the open meetings law if the committee is established by statute or if the committee makes policy recommendations and is established by or approved by the board.
