205 Committees

205.3 Citizens' Advisory Committee

Whenever the board deems it necessary, it may appoint a standing committee of the board made up of citizens from the community to study an issue and make a recommendation to the board.

The purpose and duties of the ad hoc committee shall be stated in a board resolution. The recommendation to the board shall be advisory in nature, and the board will receive the recommendation for consideration. The board retains the authority to make the final decision on the issue. The committee may be subject to the open meetings law.

Committees subject to the open meetings law are those created by executive order or those created by state statute.

It shall be the responsibility of the board in conjunction with the superintendent to appoint citizens to the committee. The committee members, if possible, will be representative of the district community and shall consider the various viewpoints on the issue.
