### **605 Student Progress**

#### **605.6 Basic Instruction Program**

The basic instruction program shall include the courses required for each grade level by the State Department of Education and as stipulated by the State of Iowa Code. The instructional approach will be nonsexist and multicultural.

The board may, in its discretion, offer additional courses in the instruction program for any grade level.

Each instruction program shall be carefully planned for optimal benefit taking into consideration the financial condition of the school district and other factors deemed relevant by the board or superintendent. Each instruction program's plan should describe the program, its goals, the effective materials, the activities and the method for student evaluation.

The responsibility rests with the superintendent to develop administrative regulations stating the required courses and optional courses for kindergarten, grades one through six, grades seven and eight, and grades nine through twelve.
