### 701 Nutrition Services

#### 701.3 Free or Reduced Cost Meals Eligibility

Students enrolled and attending school in the school district, who are unable to afford the special milk program, the cost or a portion of the cost of the school lunch, breakfast and supplemental foods, will be provided the school food program services at no cost or at a reduced cost.

It shall be the responsibility of the board secretary, in cooperation of the superintendent, to determine if a student qualifies for free or reduced cost school food services. Students eligible for free or reduced priced meals shall be determined in accordance with state and federal regulations. Students, whom the principal believes are improperly nourished, will not be denied the school food program services simply because the paperwork has not been completed.

Employees, students and others will be required to purchase tickets for meals consumed.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to develop administrative regulations for implementing this policy.
