702 Transportation

702.11 Transportation of Nonschool Groups

School district transportation vehicles may be used for transporting students and others to school-sponsored events within the state. The board in its discretion shall determine on a case-by-case basis whether to provide this transportation. In determining whether to provide this transportation, the board will consider the availability of the school district transportation vehicles, the cost and method of payment for the transportation, the number of individuals desiring the transportation, and any other factors deemed relevant by the board.

School buses may also be used by an organization of, or sponsoring activities for, senior citizens, children, handicapped persons as outlined in the Code of Iowa. The school will charge the organizations the cost of such trips. Each organization will be responsible for discipline and care while on the trip.

The Board shall not make the school district transportation vehicles available to local nonprofit entities for transporting to and from nonschool sponsored activities.
