902 Maintenance and Operation

902.11 Energy and Environmental Conservation

In concert with the board's goal to utilize public funds in an effective and efficient manner, school district personnel and students shall practice energy conservation methods when utilizing the school district's facilities. These methods include, but are not limited to, turning off lights and equipment when not in use, reducing the temperature of the facility, particularly when it is not in use, and keeping windows and doors properly closed or open, depending on the weather.

The board will also encourage faculty, staff and students to practice other means of environmental conservation whenever practicable. Such measures may include, but not be limited to, use of biodegradable items instead of plastics and styrofoam and recycling of paper and yard wastes.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to develop guidelines for school personnel and students for energy conservation and environmental preservation. It shall be the responsibility of school district personnel and students to abide by these guidelines.
