

## Winter Activities:

The following changes have been added after the Governors Proclamation on 11/10/2020

In addition to following all of the guidance from the IAHSAA, IGHSAA, and the IHSMA the River Valley Conference and the West Branch CSD have elected to put the following protocols in place:

### River Valley Conference:

- Spectators will be limited to (2 tickets) per participant (coaches/athletes)
- Tickets will be dispersed to athletes to give to their (2) spectators the night before each contest
- Having a ticket gives a spectator the right to purchase admission, admission is still charged.
- You must have a ticket to enter the game, if you forget or misplace the ticket a new one will not be given to you and admission will not be allowed
- Masks are **mandatory** for all spectators. Those not following this rule or entering without a ticket will be asked to leave
- All players/coaches on benches must wear masks during wrestling and basketball competitions
- Live Stream options available at most conference schools for those not able or wanting to attend in person
- Social distanced seating mandatory
- Team benches separated from spectators

### West Branch CSD:

- First two rows of bleachers off limits (helps further separate spectators from teams)
- Girls and Boys Basketball players at the HS level have elected to wear masks during practices/open gyms etc...
- Wrestling will take additional breaks for sanitation and hydration. Including additional mat cleaning, wrestling in small pods to limit exposure risk, and additional skin treatment options.
- The different Fine Arts ensembles are working on virtual concert options as well as planning some things for after the first of the year.
